Our rip saw has four moveable blades that work in concert with our optical scanner. It can produce infinite varieties of rips at high volume speed and accuracy, plus it reduces costs by utilizing computerized technology.

Our state-of-the-art equipment allows us to run up to 600,000 lineal feet of high quality moulding a day.

- Moulding. Using all of our eight German-made moulders we can run 600,000 lineal feet of high quality hardwood moulding a day. Yes, a day.
- Tooling. We employ cutting edge grinders to mill a precision edge on all knife stock. Each moulder head is checked with an optical comparator to insure an exact knife alignment. This produces the crisp pattern that is so important in every run.
- Embossing. Superior Italian machinery and precision dyes allow us to craft extremely high quality embossing.
- Dust Collecting. The foundation of any moulding operation is the quality and high capacity of its dust collecting system. We have one of the best.
- Packaging. We shrink wrapped our first piece of moulding over 35 years ago. Our moulding packaging expertise allows us to box, poly wrap, skin pack, paper wrap, bundle and skid all to your specifications.
